











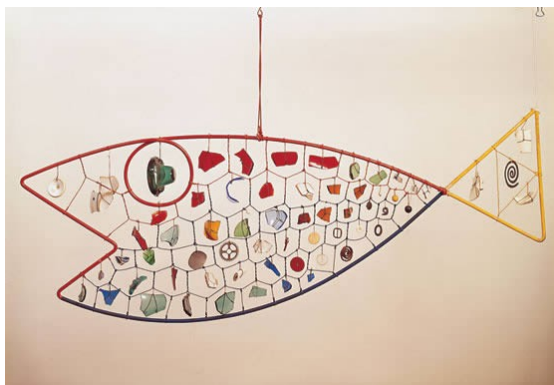
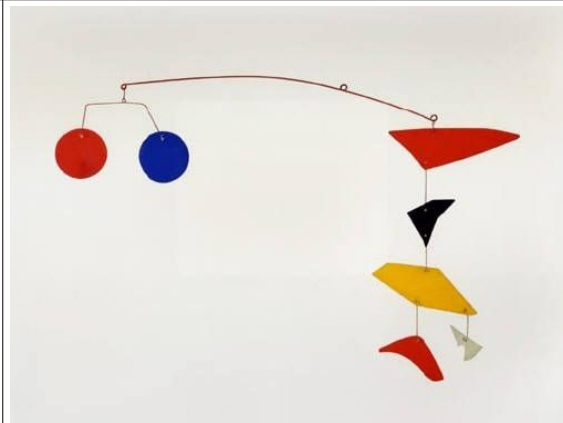


GIVE YOUR OLD STUFF A SECOND LIFE: A workshop to re-think
